

## **BIOGRAPHY NOTES – GENERAL ASSEMBLY**

### **REAR ADMIRAL MÁRIO DO CARMO DURÃO**

Rear Admiral Mário Durão graduated from the Naval School in June 1971 and from the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, USA, with a master's degree in mechanical engineering in June 1977. Between 1984 and 1994, he was appointed Professor of Thermodynamics and Mechanics of Fluids in the Naval School. From 1994 to 2013, they took on senior management roles in the ICT areas of the Navy and the Ministry of Defense, being CIO and Assistant Secretary General. He was president of AFCEA Portugal between October 2014 and October 2021, from which date he assumed the position of chairman of the General Assembly of this Chapter.

### **BRIGADIER GENERAL ANA BALTAZAR**

Brigadier General Ana Baltazar has a degree in Aeronautical Military Sciences - branch of Aeronautical Engineering, from the Air Force Academy. She obtained a master's degree in Peace and War Studies-New International Relations, and a PhD in Management at "Instituto Superior de Economia e Gestão da Universidade de Lisboa" (ISEG). She has several postgraduate degrees from "Universidade Católica Portuguesa" and NATO bodies. Throughout her career, she has held management positions at Air Bases and in the technical directions of the Air Force, she was a professor at the IUM, and Defense Attaché in Berlin. She is actually Deputy DGPDN.

### **COLONEL ANTÓNIO SALVADO**

Colonel António Salvado has a degree in Military Sciences, Weapon Transmissions, from the Military Academy, and a degree in Electrical and Computer Engineering from "Instituto Superior Técnico". He attended several courses in the areas of real-time systems, communications systems, systems administration, and project management, in universities and national and foreign companies, and in NATO training center's. He held technical and leadership roles in the area of ICT in several military units and in the MDN. Colonel António Salvado was also a professor at the Military Academy and Polytechnic Institutes and vice-president of AFCEA Portugal
